Florida Bar Lawyer Referral Service

- If you want to pursue this matter with a private attorney, you may do so by contacting the Florida Bar Lawyer Referral Service for help finding an attorney who handles your type of case.
- Established Panels:
 - The Florida Bar has established panels for Low Fee, Elderly, AIDS and Disability cases.
 - If you qualify for one of the panels, you receive a free 30-minute consultation and possibly a reduced fee if a lawyer agrees to accept your case.
 - You can inquire about this service by calling The Florida Bar Lawyer Referral Service toll-free at 1-800-342-8011.
 - Low cost fees are based on eligibility, which is based on household income and fed poverty guidelines.
 - If qualified, applicants receive first ½ hour free and, if the attorney agrees, representation at ½ their regular fee and possibly a payment plan.
 - Fee-generating cases are excluded from the low fee arrangement.
- Jacksonville Bar Lawyer Referral Service
 - If The Florida Bar Lawyer Referral Service is unable to help you, you can call the Jacksonville Bar Lawyer Referral Service at 399-5780.
 - Most attorneys who participate in the Jacksonville Bar Lawyer Referral Service charge a \$50 consultation fee for a 30 minute consultation to evaluate your case.
 - A fee for further services must be negotiated between you and the lawyer.
 - You are under no obligation to hire the lawyer following the consultation, and the lawyer is under no obligation to accept your case.
