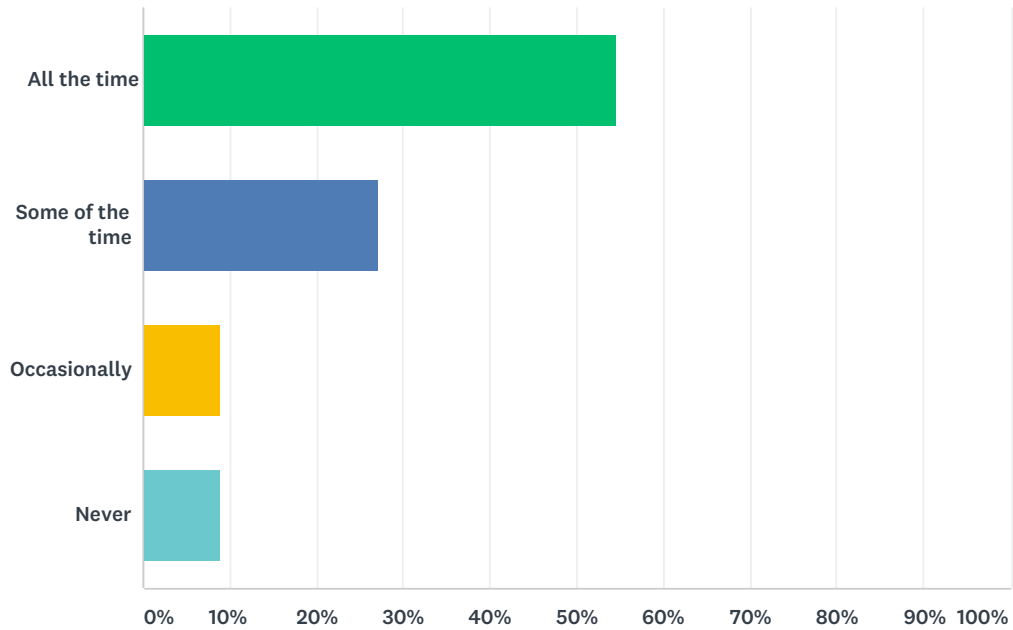


# Q1 How often do you screen patients for NFMLP assistance?

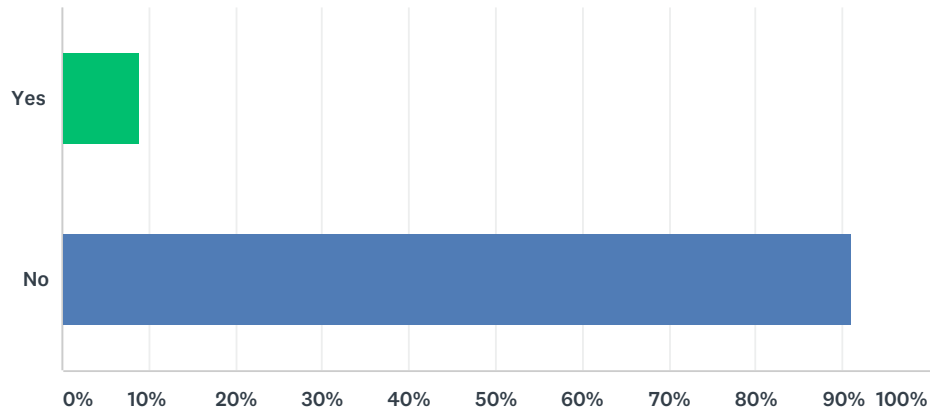

## Q2 If you screen for NFMLP assistance, do you use a screening tool?

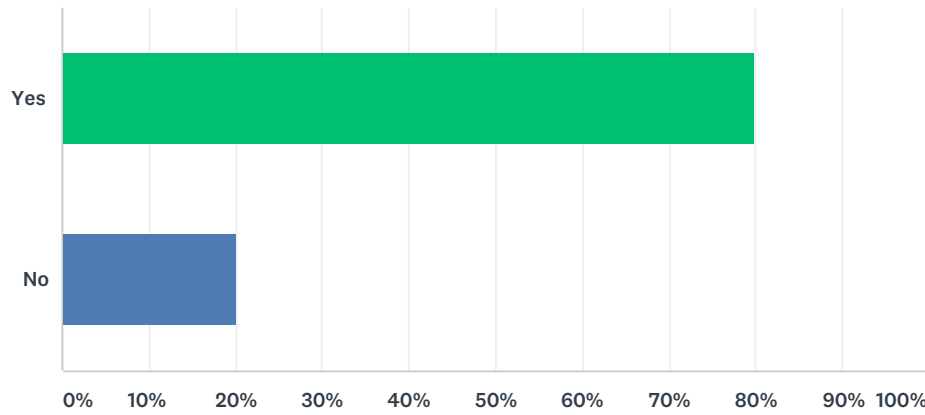

### Q3 If you do not screen for NFMLP assistance, would access to a screening tool increase the likelihood you would screen for NFMLP assistance?

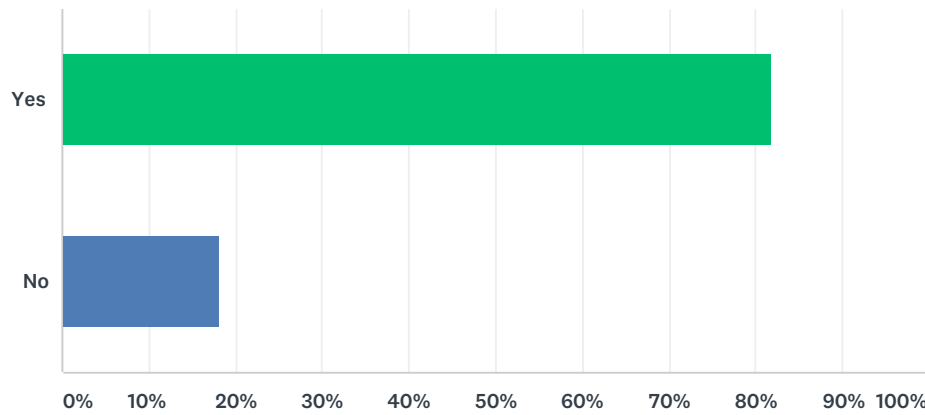

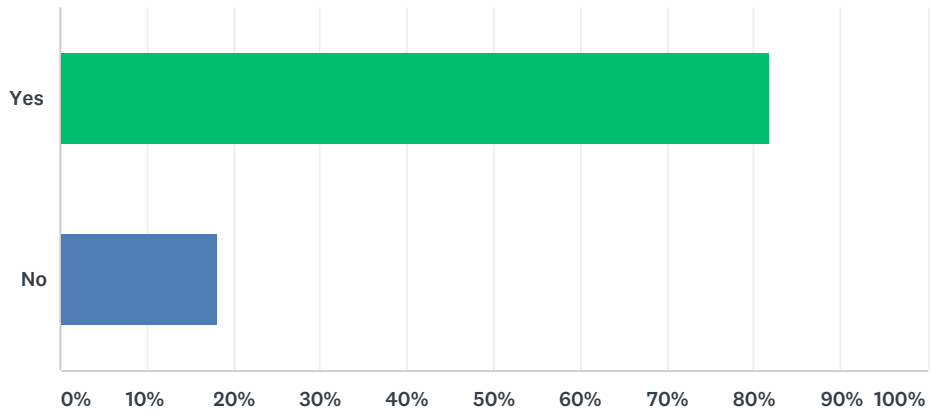

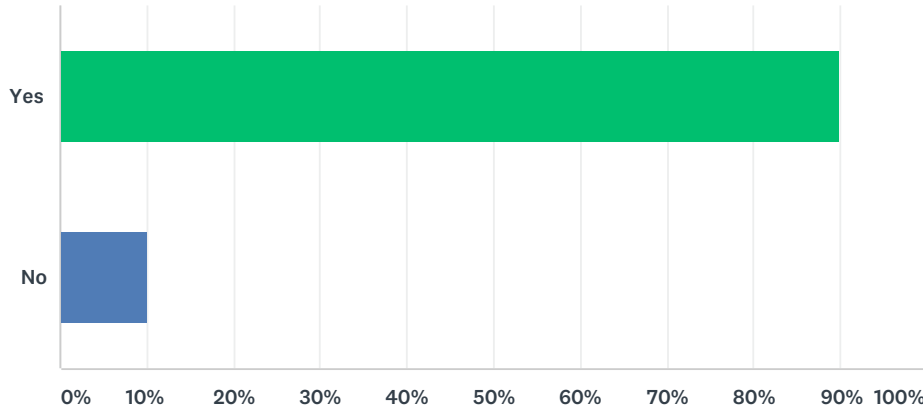

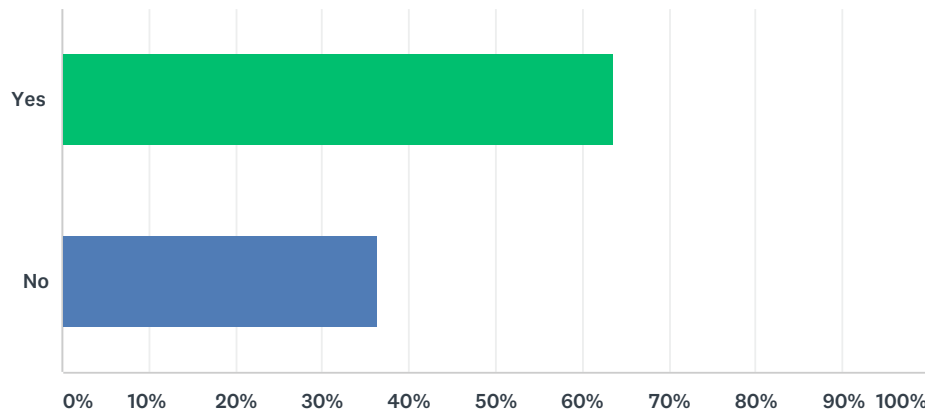

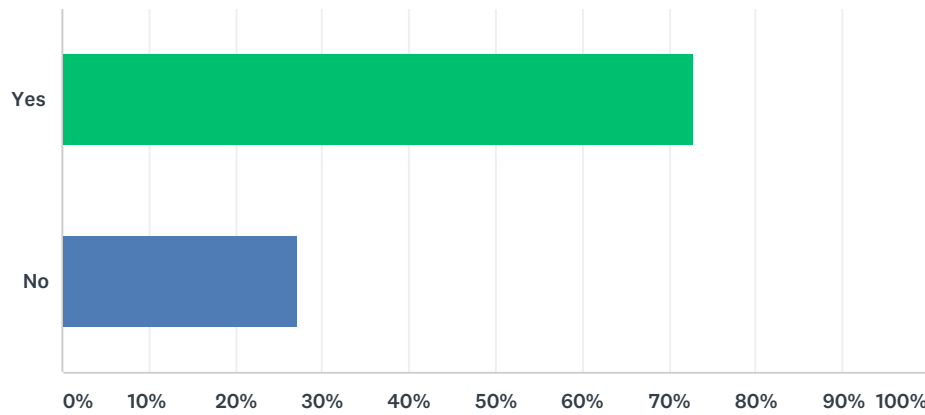

### Q10 Would a limit on the amount of NFMLP referrals a partner can submit impact your ability to assist patients?

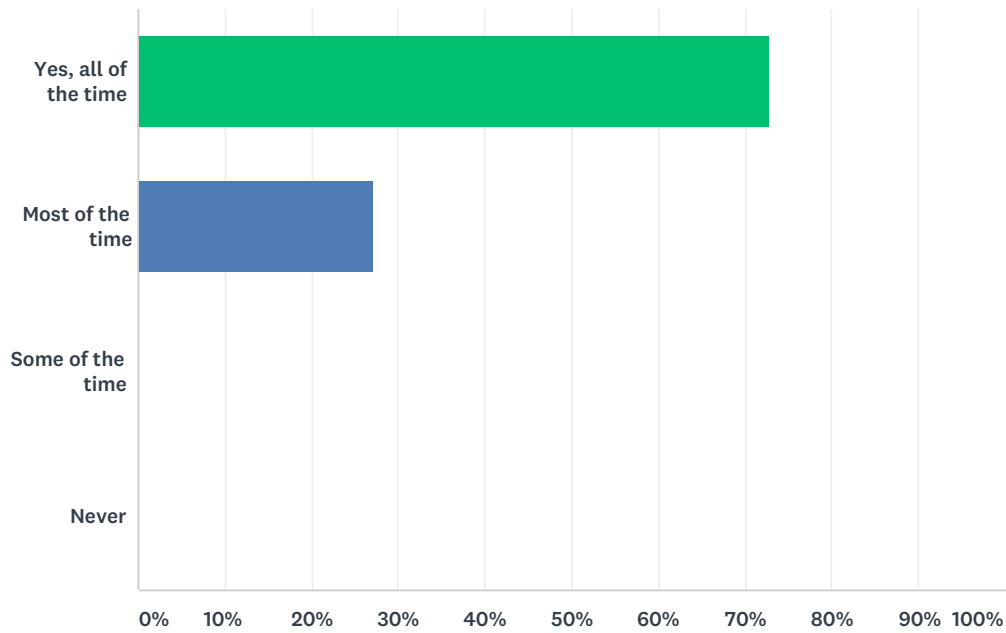

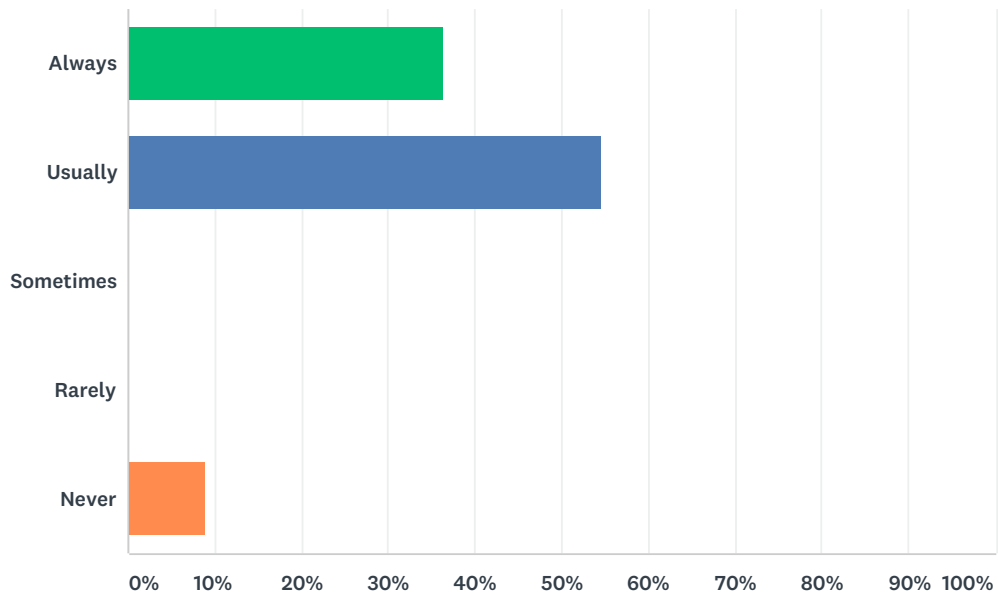

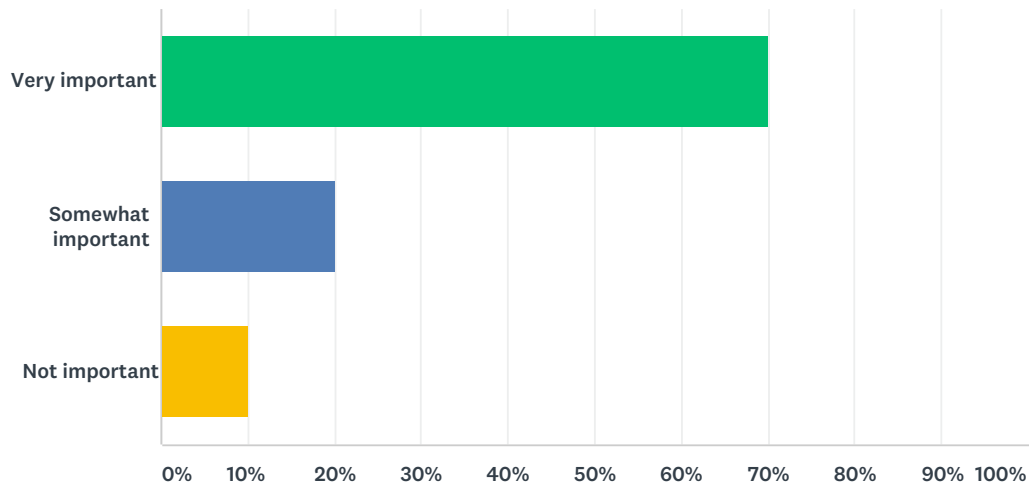

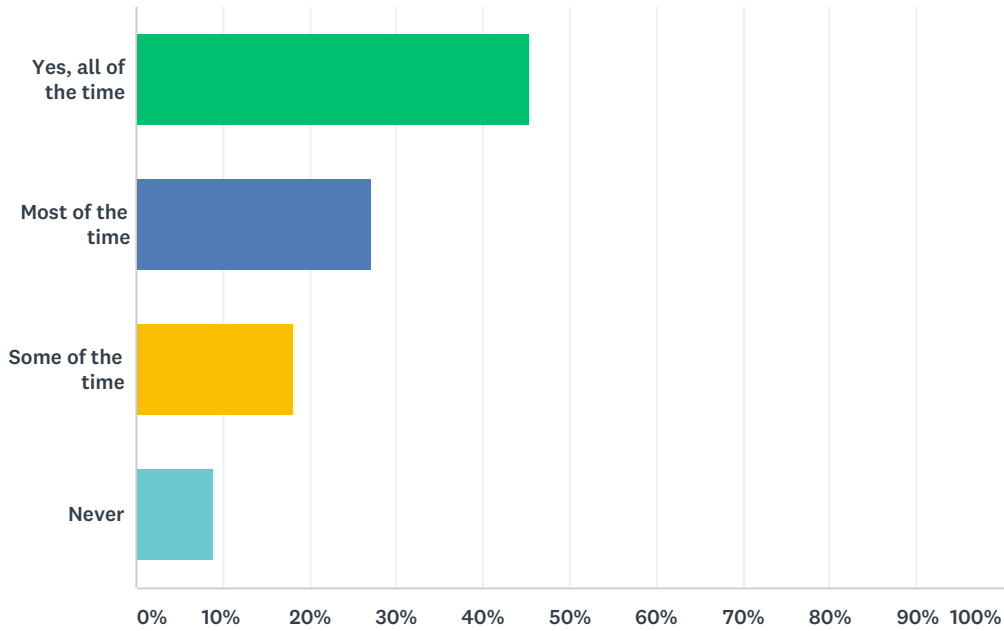

### Q15 Does the NFMLP program provide adequate information to you about how a referral was handled?

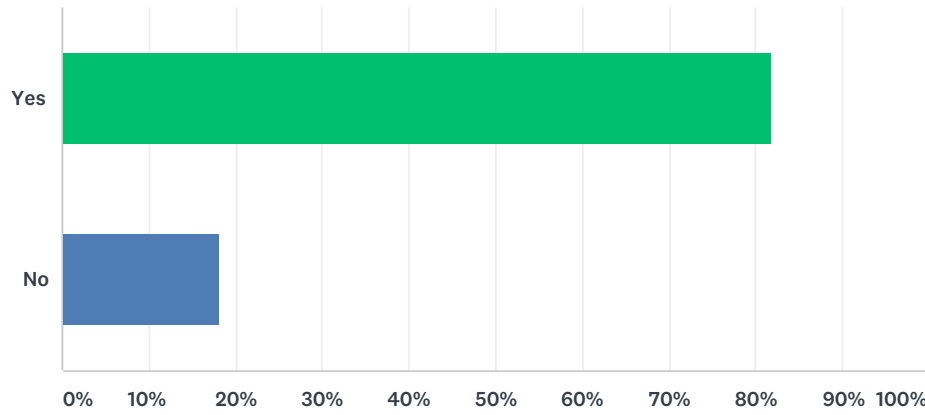

### Q16 Does the NFMLP help you treat patients?

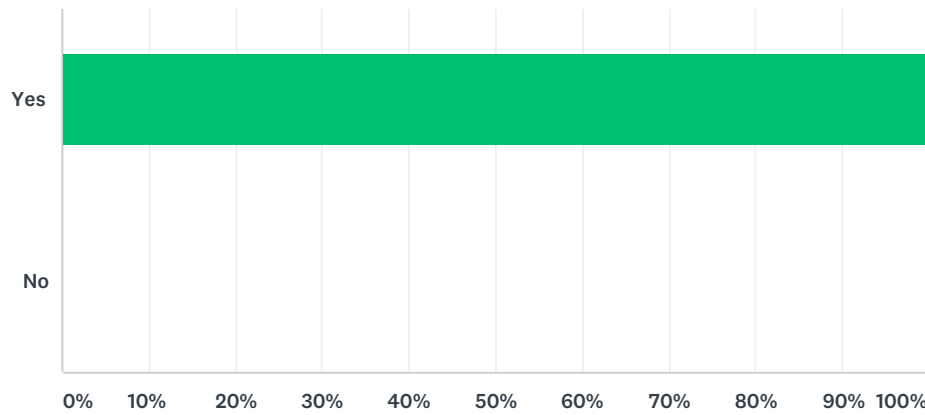

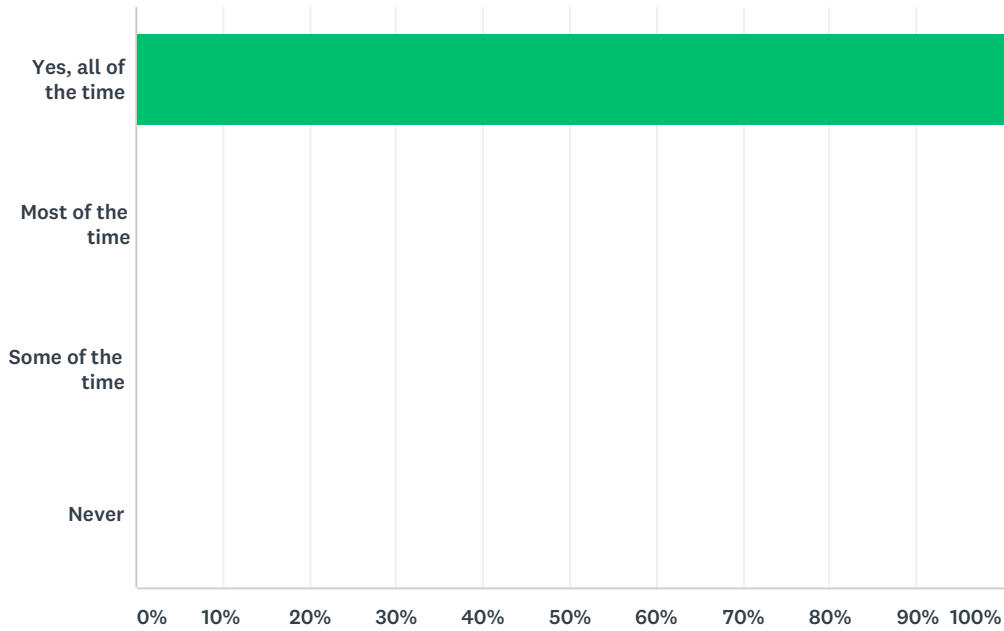

### Q18 Is the NFMLP attorney accessible to you for consultations about legal aid issues or other questions/concerns?

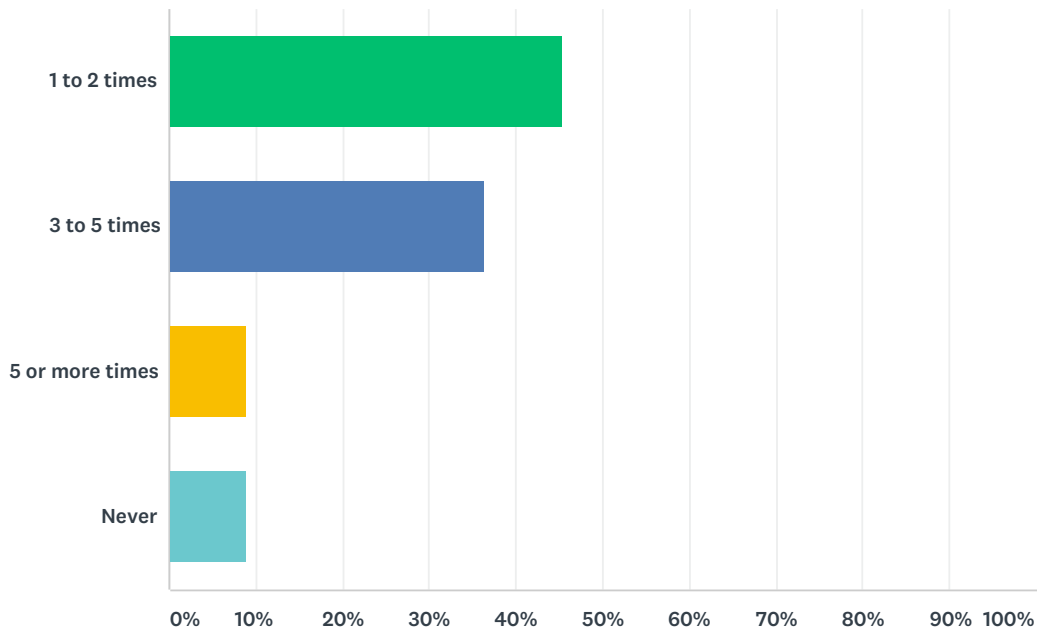

### Q19 How often each month do you consult with the NFMLP about a legal issue?

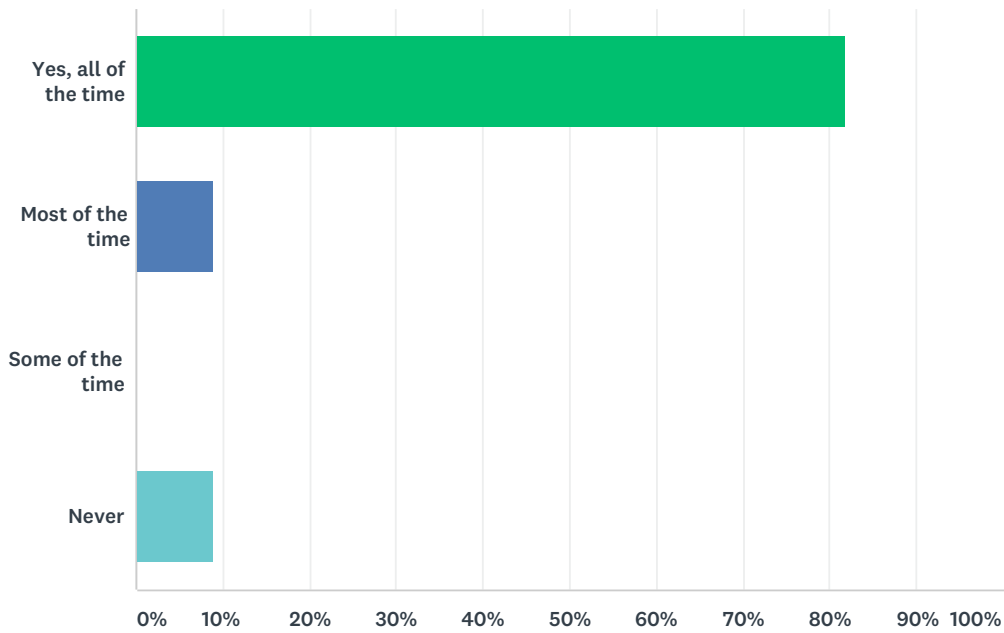

## Q20 Do you find the information provided during the NFMLP consultation useful in assisting patients?

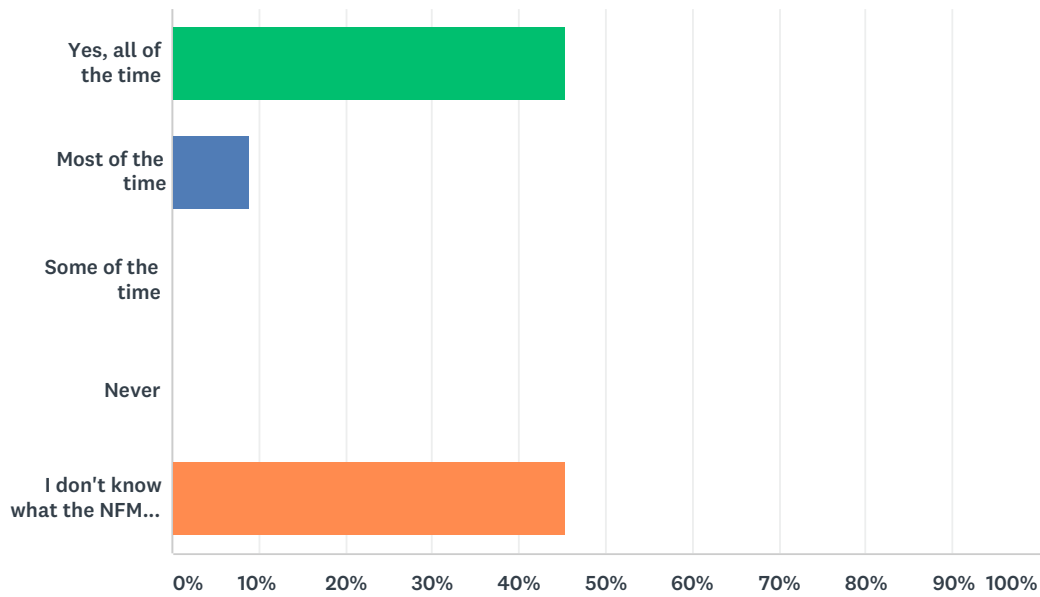

## Q21 Are the resources provided through the NFMLP Google Group useful?

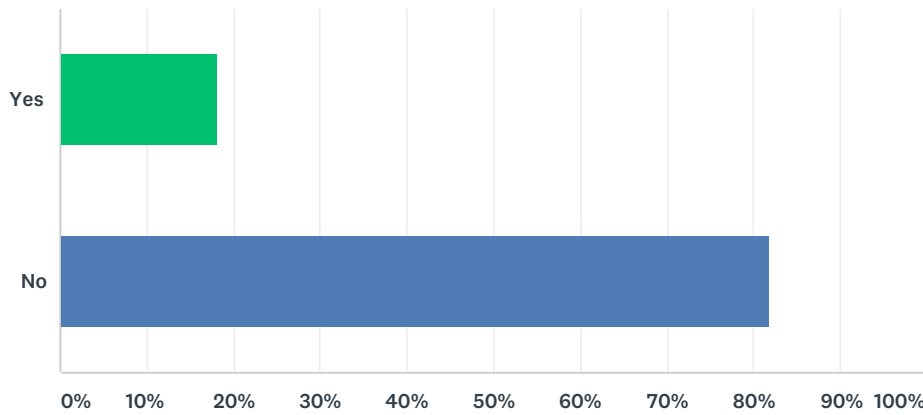

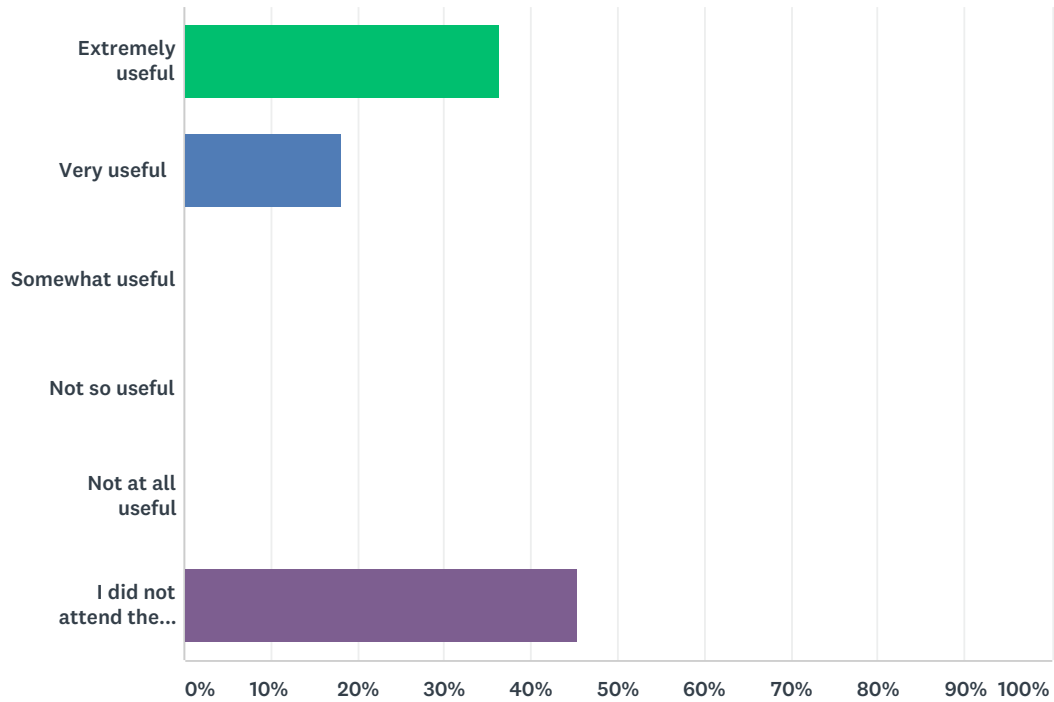

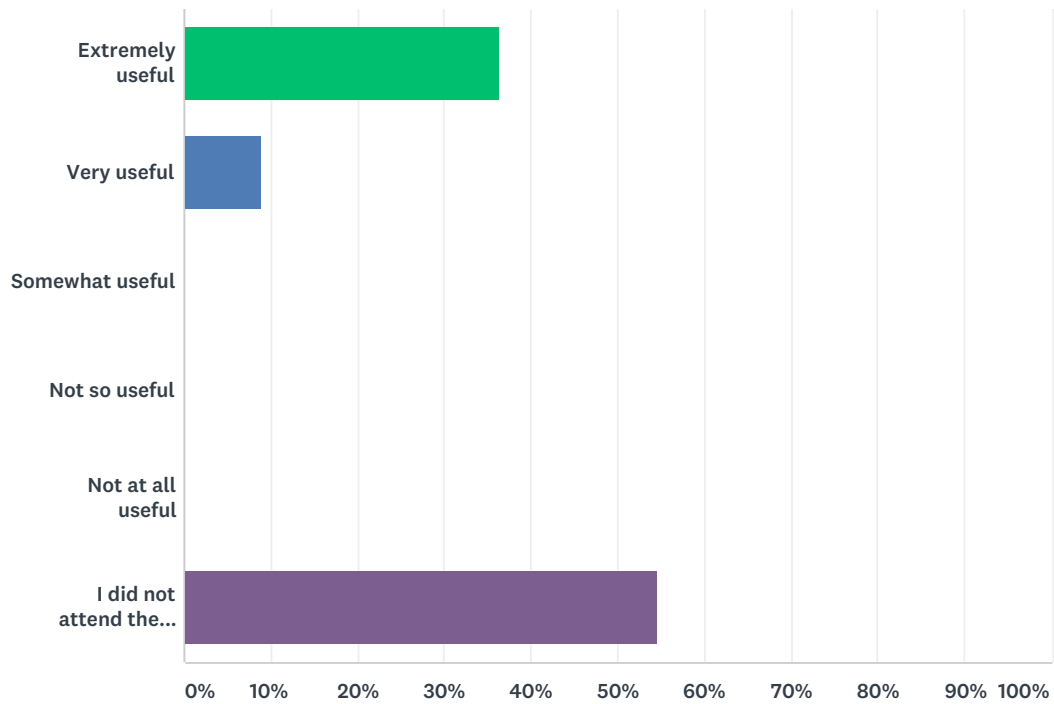

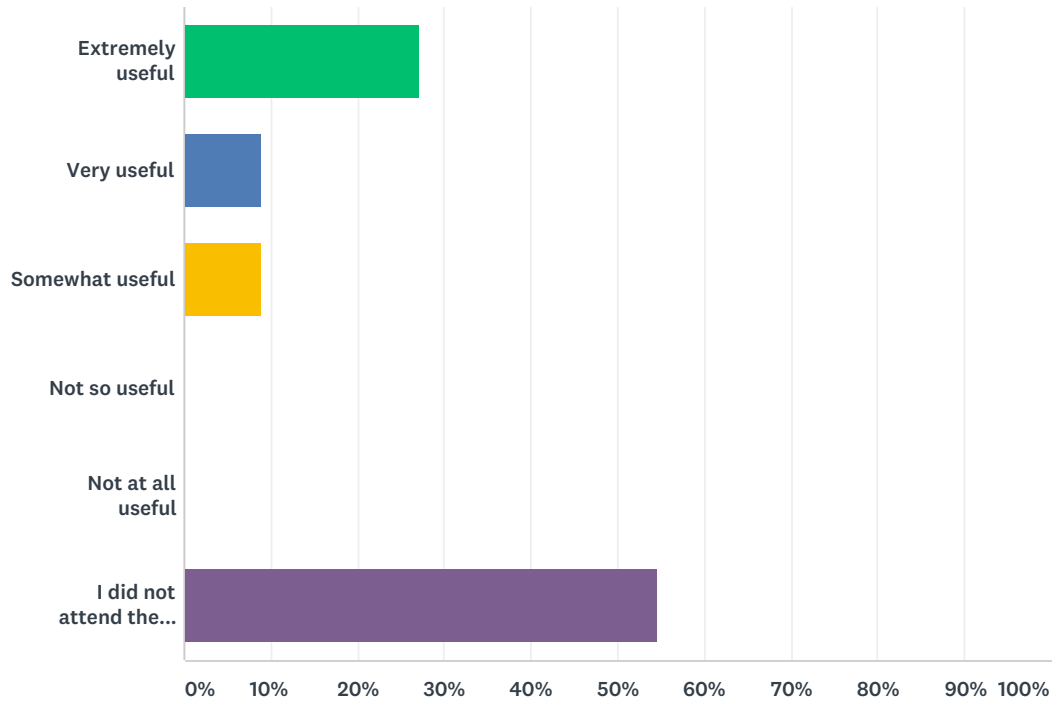

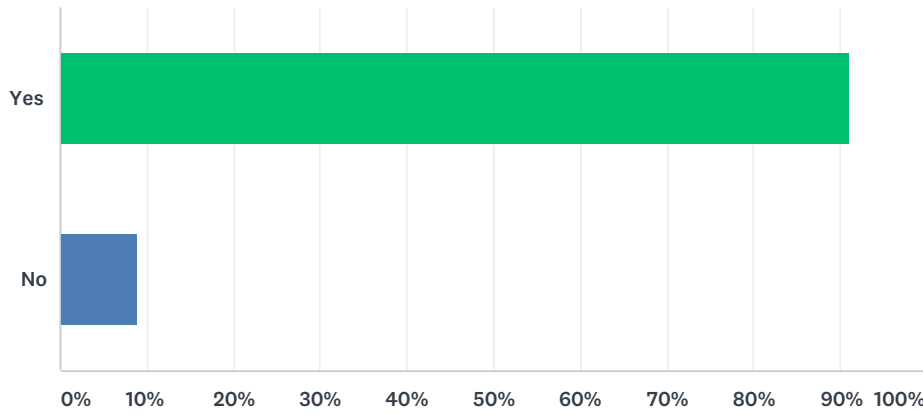

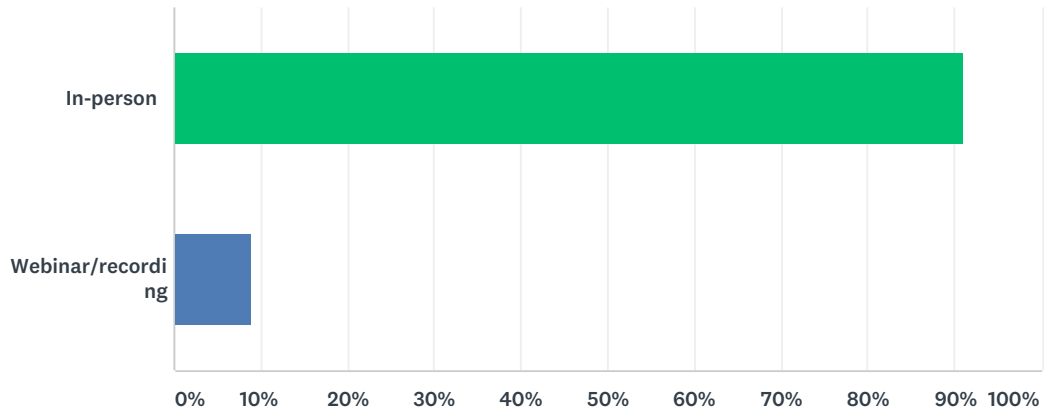
